From a personal computer, tablet or smartphone, access your favorite magazines as they hit newsstands. View concerts and shows, listen to lectures, introduce children to French language and culture, read e-books and comics, and enhance your language skills with materials tailored to your needs.

24/7 access: daily newspapers, magazines, comic books, resources for learners of French including easy readers with audio files, novels, current topics (such as WWI or the climate), educational training guides, music, concerts, filmed lectures, web documentaries, and many resources for kids are at your disposal.

Culturethèque USA is available throughout the United States and is free for participating Alliance Française members!

TO REGISTER

If you wish to join Culturethèque:
Login to www.culturetheque.com
In the CONNEXION tab, click on "SUBSCRIBE".

Select the Alliance closest to you and complete the online registration form.
Your account will be active for the same period as your Alliance membership.

If you are a member of the 28 participating Alliance françaises, your inscription is free of charge.
If you are not a member of an Alliance, you will be contacted with information on how to join the Alliance nearest you.

SEARCHING FOR DOCUMENTS

You have a choice between two types of searches: using the integrated search engine and by selecting the document suggestions on each page of the site.

- **Using the search engine**

You can use the simple search by typing in keywords (for example, Balzac, geography, Le Point, comic books, water, etc).

Selecting "All Resources" allows you to optimize the results of the simple search.

These results can also be refined by using the menu in the left-hand column (by type of document, author, language, catalogs, etc).

- **By selecting the resources** offered by your librarian on the homepage and in the tabs marked "Read," "Listen," "Watch," "Learn French," and "Kids."

VIEWING DOCUMENTS

The contents are available online (streaming) and certain documents are downloadable for a set amount of time. All of our documents are accessible from a tablet, smartphone, laptop or desktop.

In order to have access to these documents, you must be logged in.

The content available on *Culturethèque USA* is regularly updated. For certain documents, you must simply accept the conditions of the new site upon your first visit.

Ebooks

Once you download a book, you can read your borrowed copy for a set borrowing period. After your due date, the eBook will no longer be accessible on your device and the book will once again become available in the digital library.

The majority of our eBooks are in the epub format (not available for kindle readers). In order to read epub eBooks, you will first need to install a free program called Adobe Digital Editions onto your device. [Download Adobe Digital Editions here.](#)

Magazines

Magazines are accessible online (streaming). You will need to follow the links “View the document,” and “Read the magazine.”

Comic Books

Comic books are also available streaming online. You will be able to view extracts of the comic book or read the full text.

Music and videos

Music and videos are available online, streaming.

In order to view some of our streaming films, you will first need to activate java.

How can I save my selections?

You can create a personal library by placing selected items in your “basket.”

I lost my password. What should I do?

Contact your library.

Can I connect to Culturethèque USA while traveling outside the USA?

For legal and commercial reasons, connection to Culturethèque USA can only be made from a device whose IP address is recognized as being within the USA.

Can I copy or download documents from Culturethèque USA?

For legal and commercial reasons, most documents are accessible only while streaming. However, other documents are legally downloadable for a limited time.

I am logged into Culturethèque USA, but despite many attempts, I cannot access ToutApprendre.com.

Access to this site may be temporarily unavailable because the maximum number of simultaneous connections has been reached. Please try again later.

It may also be due to the configuration of your computer. Some Mac or Linux products do not allow access to all content. This may also be true for some tablets.

Are all resources only in French?

Please note that there are resources in languages other than French.
